### Issue and Return of Ballot Papers and Voting Information

Voting information will be issued by email to those members who have provided the Trust with a valid email address. Ballot papers will be issued by post to all other members in eligible constituencies. All members will be able to vote via the internet at [www.mi-vote.com](http://www.mi-vote.com), using the unique voter code contained in the email or printed on the ballot paper. Members who receive a postal voting pack will also have the option of voting by post. All votes, whether cast via the internet or by post, must be received by the Returning Officer by **5.00pm on Friday 30 November 2018**. **Lost Ballot Papers** If a voter has not received his or her voting information email or ballot paper an application may be made to the Returning Officer for a replacement.

**Spoilt Ballot Papers** If a voter spoils his or her ballot paper an application may be made to the Returning Officer for a replacement.

Replacement voting information may be issued by email until the close of poll. Replacement ballot papers may be issued by post until **2.00pm on Thursday 29 November 2018**.
